## **DOT Announces \$4.2 Billion for National Infrastructure Projects**

This week, the Department of Transportation (DOT) announced more than \$4.2 billion in funding from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law through two major discretionary grant programs, the National Infrastructure Project Assistance (Mega) grant program and the Infrastructure for Rebuilding America (INFRA) grant program. A total of 44 projects were selected in this round of funding, including projects that improve safety, mobility, and economic competitiveness, constructing major bridges, expanding port capacity, redesigning interchanges, and more. ## FAA Announces \$970 Million in Airport Infrastructure Improvements

Yesterday, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) announced they are awarding \$970 million from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law to 125 U.S. airports, spanning 46 states, Guam, and Palau. The awards include funding for new airport terminals, air traffic control towers, baggage systems, larger security checkpoints, increasing gate capacity, and modernizing aging infrastructure throughout terminals and ground transportation.
